Highlights (as at 3 January 2021):

- RMCO extended to 31 March 2021
- The whole of Selangor and KL are red zones. Perlis remains green.
- Total active cases – 21,365, of which Selangor (47%), KL (19%), Sabah (16%), Johor (15%), and remaining 3% in other states.
- Recovery rate: 81.6%
- Fatality rate: 0.4%

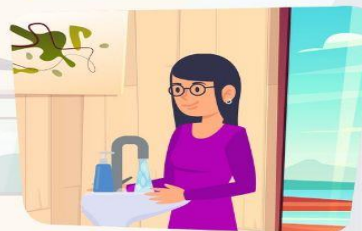

Coronavirus mutation no reason to panic: News sources

- According to British authorities, the new virus variant – B.1.1.7 - is known to be 50% more contagious than the previously known form
- Mutations are common and the new virus variant with currently 17 mutations have been spotted– has spread to Europe, the Middle East, America and many others.
- But the newly registered mutation won't make the new vaccines ineffective. These vaccines are all designed to encode the information for the coronavirus spike protein in such a way that it will still stimulate the immune system despite the mutation.
- However, the new variant does not appear to be more deadly, and it may potentially weaken the virus over time.
