

COVID-19 Alert: 29 November 2020





Highlights (as at 29 Nov 2020):

- -> 1309 new cases recorded with highest increase in Kuala Lumpur (+493), followed by Sabah (+290).
- -> Out of the 493 new cases in Kuala Lumpur, 473 cases were from the construction site clusters
- -> Three fatalities recorded which put the latest death toll at 357 people (0.6% fatality rate)
- -> Total recovery surged to 1,333, putting the total recovered cases at 52,647 (81.6% recovery rate)
- -> Total active cases at 11,481, of which 116 are in ICU and 42 require breathing apparatus.

Coronavirus: Malaysia secures 12.8 million Pfizer vaccines as China assures Muhyiddin of 'priority status'

- •The US firm will deliver one million doses in the first quarter of 2021, and the deal is expected to cover 6.4 million Malaysians
- •Prime Minister Muhyiddin Yassin said Beijing had assured him that Malaysia would be given priority access to its vaccines
- •It was reported that Muhyiddin, however, said Pfizer would still need approval from the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and regulatory approval from the producing country, besides approval from the Malaysia's National Pharmaceutical Regulatory Agency (NPRA) for the vaccine to be used in Malaysia.
