
COVID-19 Alert : 2 May 2021




Highlights (as at 2 May 2021):

3,418 new cases recorded with highest increase in Selangor (+1,200), representing 35%,

Fresh cases rose above 3,000 for the first time to 3,142 on 28 April 2021 since February 4 198).

R-naught nationwide registered at 1.11 on 2 May 2021 with the actual increase of new **COVID-19 cases** (black line) surpassed the Health Ministry's latest projection (red area).

RM8 Million COVID-19 Test Fund



- The Life Insurance Association of Malaysia (LIAM), Persatuan Insurans Am Malaysia (PIAM) and the Malaysian Takaful Association (MTA) have established the COVID-19 Test Fund (CTF) to support the Ministry of Health's (MoH) efforts to conduct more COVID-19 testing for the benefit of medical insurance policyholders and takaful certificate holders.
- RM8 million has been pledged by the insurance and takaful industry to this fund.
- Medical insurance policyholders and takaful certificate holders may apply for reimbursement up to a maximum of RM300 for COVID-19 testing (one reimbursement per individual) to maximize the number of tests that can be supported by the CTF.





- Malaysia's daily new confirmed COVID-19 cases per capita surpassed UK since April 9, as Malaysia battles a fresh surge of infections.
- According to Our World in Data, Malaysia recorded 93.48 new COVID-19 cases per million people on April 30, almost triple the UK's 32.95 cases, based on a rolling seven-day average.
- This represents an increase of almost 150% compared to 37.42 new cases per capita on March 31, based on a rolling seven-day average.
