COVID-19 Alert: 03 October 2021





Highlights (as at 03 October 2021):

• Malaysia recorded 9,066 new Covid-19 cases on Sunday (Oct 3), bringing the cumulative total to 2,277,565. Sarawak recorded the highest number of cases at 1,418, followed by Selangor (1,000) and Johor (981).

AIR VENTILATION



- The vast majority of SARS-CoV-2 transmission occurs indoors, most of it from the inhalation of airborne particles that contain the coronavirus. The best way to prevent the virus from spreading in a home or business would be to simply keep infected people away. But this is hard to do when an estimated 40% of cases are asymptomatic and asymptomatic people can still spread the coronavirus to others.
- Masks do a decent job at keeping the virus from spreading into the environment, but if an infected person is inside a building, inevitably some virus will escape into the air.
- Once the virus escapes into the air inside a building, you have two options: bring in fresh air from outside or remove the virus from the air inside the building.
- Keeping windows and doors open is a good start. Putting a box fan in a window blowing out can greatly increase air exchange too.
