COVID-19 Alert: 7 November 2021





Figures at a Glance:

- Downward trend continues with less than
 4,500 new cases after 174 days since 17th May.
- 98.4% (or 4,275 out of 4,343) of the cases consisted of Category 1 & 2.
- 7 new clusters were detected, 3 involving communities, 3 involving work places and 1 linked to higher institution.
- R-naught nationwide registered at 0.92 with the highest in WP Putrajaya (1.03), followed by WP Kuala Lumpur (1.00) and Selangor (0.99).
- So far, more than 75% of our population (>95% of our adult population) have been fully vaccinated and approximately 78% of our population (about 98% of our adult population) have received at least first dose of the vaccine.
- MOH is targeting the vaccination rate for adolescents to reach 80% by November.
- More of our senior citizens getting their
 COVID-19 booster shot, in line with our
 strategy to protect the most vulnerable in our
 society as we transition towards endemicity.

- In a statement, Health director-general Tan Sri Dr Noor Hisham said the AY.4.2, which is also known as the Delta Plus variant, was detected from two Malaysian students who returned from the United Kingdom (UK) on Oct 2.
- Dr Noor Hisham said the vaccines currently used were still effective against AY.4.2 variant and measures such as quarantine and testing could help to reduce the risk of transmission of this variant in Malaysia, particularly at international entry points.
 - 3,762 Variant of Concern were detected as at 6th November, out of which 94% or 3,522 consisted of Delta.
