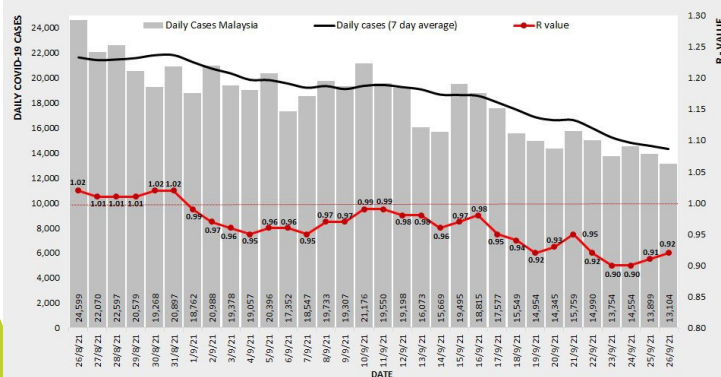
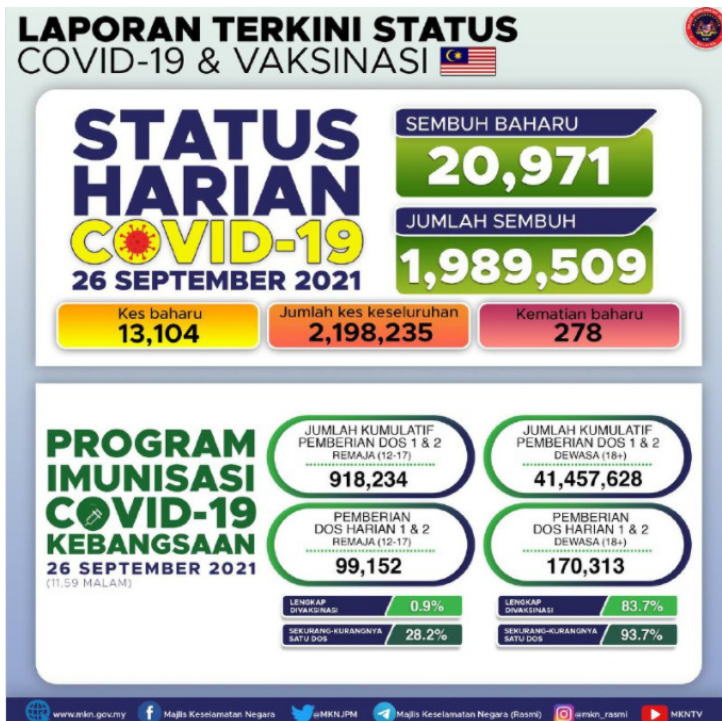


# COVID-19 Alert : 26 September 2021



## Figures at a Glance:

- 13,104, cases reported on 26<sup>th</sup> September, lowest in 66 days, out of which only 1.5% involving category 3, 4 and 5.
- Sarawak recorded the highest at 2,943, followed by Selangor (1,558) and Johor Bharu (1,455).
- 12 new clusters detected, with half of them involving workplaces and the remaining six linked to communities.
- R-naught nationwide registered at 0.92 – the reading for Johor, Kelantan, WP Putrajaya, Pahang, Perak, Terengganu, Sarawak and Perlis exceeded nationwide average.
- So far more than 83% of our adult population have been fully vaccinated and approximately 94% of our population have received at least first dose of the vaccine.
- About 30.1% of 2.53 million students from the age brackets of 12 to 17 years have received their first doses of Covid-19 vaccine under PICK Remaja commenced on 23<sup>rd</sup> September.
- Sarawak will start administering booster doses in October, will be first state to do so.

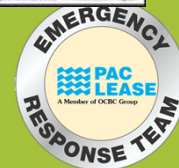

"The effectiveness of this device is dependent on its dispersion ability, the disinfectant type used and its concentration, as well as the contact time between disinfectant and surface," he said in a statement on Tuesday (Sep 21).

Currently, the Health DG added that several surface disinfectants have been identified to be effective against SARS-CoV-2 such as alcohol 70%-90%, hydrogen peroxide, thymol, quaternary ammonia, and chlorine-based solutions.

However, the Health Ministry warned that the disinfecting solution mentioned is for the purpose of surface disinfections and not meant to be used directly on humans.

"This is due to the fact that contact with some of this solution may cause irritation to the eyes, skin, respiratory and gastrointestinal system. It is also important to highlight that the use of nano mist does not replace the requirement for standard surface cleaning," said Dr Noor Hisham.

Nano mist sprayers ranging from spray guns to handheld sprays deliver particles which are widely used for various purposes including cosmetics, perfume, domestic and industrial use.
